

SCOUTING

The Guyana Police Force in an effort to create another recreational venue and training facility for our young people has resuscitated the Police Scout Group. This group like scouts the world over will aim at supporting young people in their physical, mental and spiritual development, so that they may play constructive roles in society.

Scouting may be seen as a voluntary nonpolitical and educational movement which is geared to train young people in achieving their full physical, intellectual, social and spiritual potentials. This group will incorporate programs of formal and informal education while still placing emphasis on practical activities.

SCOUT METHOD

The Guyana Police Force Scout Group will follow the principles by which the Scouting organizations operate. It will be opened to all without distinction and with a view to developing and molding young people for the wider world.

AGE GROUPS AND SECTIONS

The Guyana Police Force Scout movement will be divided into sections by age grouping, allowing activities to be modified to the maturity of the group members.

HOW TO JOIN THE SCOUT GROUP

The Guyana Police Force Scout Group is open to all young persons between the ages of seven and eighteen.

There are no barriers to race, religion, class or gender. It is not an elite group; however, persons who would like to join must have in their possession:

- A Birth Certificate
- Two (2) photographs

and should report to the Police Sports Club on Saturdays where meetings are held between 1400h. and 1600h.

Voluntary

- Anyone is free to join.
- Anyone can leave at anytime.
- Membership is based on the free acceptance of the purpose, aims and principles of the group.
